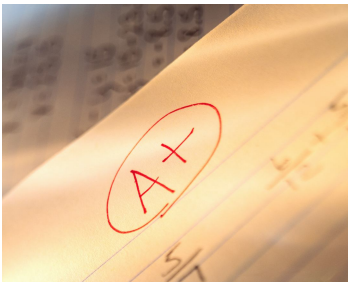

Program Overview

Welcome to the Secondary program at Victory Christian School. Our teachers provide a Christian basis for social and academic development. The secondary students are encouraged to focus on building study skills and gaining knowledge in all subject matter to enable them to be successful in the world of work. Students are given the opportunity to be involved in community service activities, extra-curricular activities, mission events, and work study programs which allow them to grow in their character and intellect.

About our Curriculum

The curriculum for Junior and Senior High builds on the basic foundations learned in elementary school and continues to expand the thought and skill processes of the student. Students are scheduled into the required courses of Language Arts (English for Senior high), Math, Social Studies, Science, Physical Education and Bible. French, Music, Art and Computers are mandatory options for Junior High Students. The required CALM 20 course is offered on a rotational basis for Senior High Students. In



addition to required courses, students are able to select elective classes to complete their schedules.

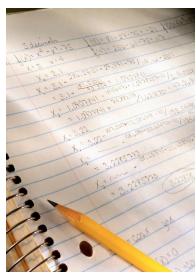
Depending on student interest, electives offered *may* include:

Chapel Service

Our Schedule

Classes begin at 8:30am and dismiss at 3:05pm. The day begins with pledges of allegiance, the singing of the national anthem, and morning prayer.

Program Costs

Victory Christian School is an independent Christian School, therefore, the Government of Alberta does not provide the full funding that is needed to ensure quality education for each child. To ensure that each student's needs are met a tuition fee is charged. 10 or 12 month payment options are available, as well as discounts for subsequent children in a family.

There is a \$100 non-refundable application fee required when application forms are submitted.

Class Size

Small class sizes are a key asset of Victory Christian School. There is a low student-teacher ratio which enables students to receive assistance and instruction from the teacher in a beneficial manner. Classes range from 15-20 students.

Bussing

Victory Christian School provides a bus service for a nominal monthly fee. Please contact the school office for further information.

Teachers

Victory Christian School hires only accredited teachers who hold at minimum a Bachelor of Education Degree recognized in the Province of Alberta.

Uniforms

Each student is required to be in uniform, which is as follows:

- White, burgundy, or navy VCS polo shirt
 - White or blue Oxford shirt
 - Plaid Kilt (Girls only)
 - Navy or Khaki pants (*girls can wear pants during the winter months*)
 - VCS sweater (optional)
- (above items must be purchased through the school office)**
- Black dress shoes
 - Navy blue sweater (pull over, zippered, button up, no sweatshirt material, no hooded sweaters)
 - Navy tie
 - Black belt
- (these items can be purchased elsewhere)**

How to Register

Registration begins on March 1st preceding the September of desired enrollment. Registration packages are available from the Victory Christian School office. Students will be considered for enrollment based on an interview process and availability of spaces in the class.
